Internet Access

CHOOSING A NETWORK

The IT department supplies WiFi network access in all campus buildings and in several outdoor areas such as the first-year quad and Pratt Field.

We broadcast two SSIDs:

EDUROAM

The primary WiFi for Amherst College students, faculty, and staff, as well as for visitors from other institutions that support eduroam. Members of Amherst College, and other eduroam enabled institutions, should log on to this WiFi network as normal.

AMHERSTGUEST

AmherstGuest provides WiFi services to campus visitors and network connectivity for smart and WiFi eabled devices. This latter group includes Rokus, Chromecasts, Playstations, smart TVs, Amazon Echos, and many other devices.

CONNECTING TO A NETWORK

MOBILE DEVICES, TABLETS AND COMPUTERS

Connect your phone, tablet, or computer to AmherstGuest WiFi. If your web browser doesn't pop-up automatically then open it. You'll automatically be redirected to the Amherst network welcome page. If you've already created an Amherst network account, click the login link. If you haven't, click the create account link and follow the directions.

SMART DEVICES

Smart and WiFi enabled devices such as Rokus, Chromecasts, Playstations, smart TVs, Amazon Echos, and other devices which connect to the internet but do not have a web browser, will need to be individually added to the AmherstGuest network.
